Dress Shirt	Lands End plaid poplin shirt (Hunter Classic Navy Plain pattern only)	Preschool - 8th Grade
Knit Shirt	Navy or uniform green, collared, two or three button, long or short sleeved, plain	Preschool - 8th Grade
Sweater	Navy or uniform green, long sleeve, cardigan, crew neck, or v-neck	Preschool - 8th Grade
Sweatshirt	Navy or uniform green, non-hooded, must have St. Monica logo or CSGK logo	Preschool - 8th Grade

Shorts	Navy, classic style (i.e. Dockers) only, may be worn between March 31st and October 31st. Khaki, classic style (i.e. Dockers) only, may be worn between March 31st and October 31st.	Preschool - 8th Grade Grades 7th and 8th Grade Only
Slacks or Cords	Navy, classic style (i.e. Dockers) only, no flares, natural waist Khaki, classic style (i.e. Dockers) only, no flares, natural waist	Preschool - 8th Grade Grades 7th and 8th Grade Only

Belts	Navy, brown, or black, plain, no wider than 1 to 1 1/2 inches, must be visible, plain belt buckle	Grades 2nd - 8th Grade
Socks	Blue or white only, over ankles, crew length cuffed sock These should measure 5" above the top of the shoe (approximately a full hand width). Athletic socks may be worn with the modified uniform only between March 31st and October 31st.	Preschool - 8th Grade

Dress Shoes	May be worn year round, closed back only	Preschool - 8th Grade
Sandals	Brown or black, closed back only, may be worn between March 31st and October 31st	Preschool - 8th Grade
Tennis Shoes	May be worn year round, no rollers allowed	Preschool - 8th Grade

Jewelry	Wrist watches and religious necklaces only	Grades 5th - 8th
Gym Uniform	Royal blue "Spirit" or "Royals" shirt, with appropriate lengthed shorts	Grades 5th - 8th
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All shirts must be tucked in. Please make sure shirts are long enough to stay tucked in. - The St. Monica logo is allowed on all shirts if they are ordered through Schoolbelles, Lands End, or Educational Outfitters. - Pants must be classic style (i.e. Dockers). No extra pockets, loops, or buttons allowed. No flares of any width (i.e. the ankle cannot be any wider than the knee). - Uniforms must be clean and in good repair. - Hairstyles should not be overly conspicuous or distracting. Some examples of this include (but are not limited to) non-natural coloring and partial shaving. Hairstyles must exemplify a clean-cut appearance. 		

All items listed above may be found in either the Schoolbelles, Educational Outfitters, or Lands End catalog. Many local stores carry uniform school wear. If you do not purchase from these companies, you must be sure the items look exactly like those featured in either of the above-mentioned catalogs/stores.

Our uniform policy allows only the above-mentioned wear. In the past, many varieties of styles have been accepted. Current styles and fad clothing are not acceptable. Students who do not follow the dress code will be given one verbal warning for the first infraction. A second infraction will be addressed through a written "write-up", and a third will result in a Uniform Holiday privilege being revoked.
